They should be able to sit and listen for short periods of time without getting distracted.



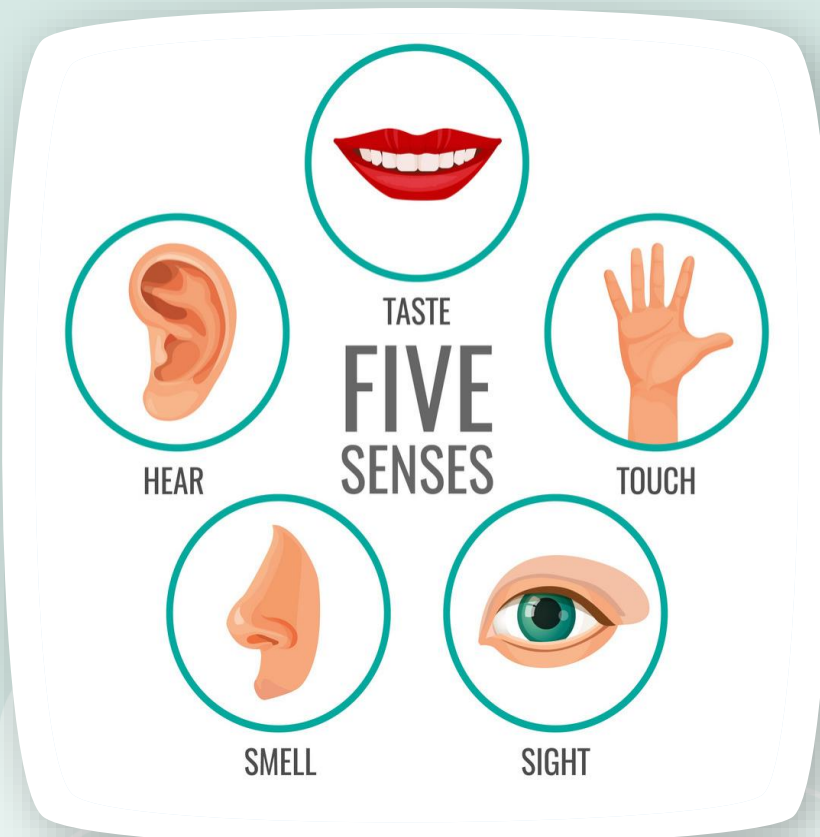
