Installation of a 4-lane running track and football pitch in fenced off and gated area. The installation will enhance the provision we have by providing a multi-use area. <b>Mental Wellbeing</b> Year 6 Sats Yoga £30.00	Yoga session on first day of SATS so children learn relaxation techniques before their SAT test.
