How are we spending the National Sports Funding?

As you may be aware the Government has given schools a large amount of money for the next two years (approximately £9000 each year for Ashbeach) to improve children's sports skills and encourage competition. The aim is for schools to be self sufficient by the end of 2014-2015.

At Ashbeach we have put in place a comprehensive programme to further improve the skills of teaching staff and the children and to develop resources for the school. This is what we have planned for this year:

- coaches and a dance teacher working alongside staff on a weekly basis;
- free after school clubs open for key stage two children;
- coaches to provide club-style activities for key stage one children one lunch time a week;
- training for staff on areas identified through a skills audit;
- outside agency to set up competition with other local schools.

We look forward to the children reaping the benefits from all that the sports funding is able to provide.
