

Olympic Legacy Sport Premium Funding 2013/14

Current numbers on roll (nor) Reception - y6 = 144

Number of children in Reception and years 1 - 6 who are **eligible** for Sport Premium on the January 2013 School Census = 119

Funding received: £8000 plus £5 per pupils aged 5-11 years old = **£8,595**

Background:

In April 2013, the Government announced new funding of £150 million for Physical Education (PE) and sport. This funding should be used to improve the quality and breadth of PE and Sport provision. The funding is for the period 1 September 2013 - 31 August 2014 & September 2014 to August 2015. This funding is ring fenced to be used for sport specific areas to make an impact in Physical Education and Sport in schools.

Schools are free to determine how best to use this funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and Sport provision, including increasing participation in PE and Sport so that all pupils develop healthy lifestyles and reach the performance levels they are capable of.

During the academic year September 2013 to July 2014 we plan to spend our funding in the following areas:

- *Coaches and a dance teacher working alongside teachers on a weekly basis*
- *Free after school clubs - ks1 and ks2*
- *Training for staff on areas identified from audit of skills and supply costs incurred by this*
- *Outside agencies to set up competitions with local schools and transport for this*
- *Resources to improve the sporting opportunities for our children*

Academic Sports Development Limited are our chosen providers for coaching as they allow staff to have coaches and CPD on a weekly basis throughout the year, covering all aspects of sports and multi-skills. The cost of our package is **£ 7740** (£510 per term for clubs and £2070 per term for coaches)
