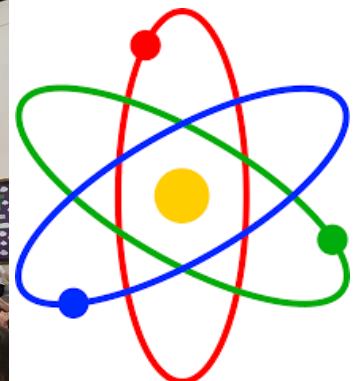
Dear parents and carers

the office know if they have any childcare requirements before or afterschool. If there

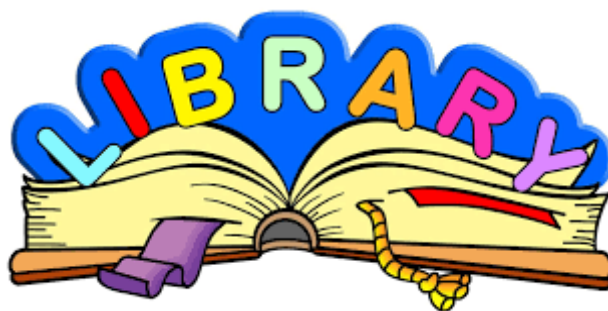


is sufficient demand then we will look to reopening the service.

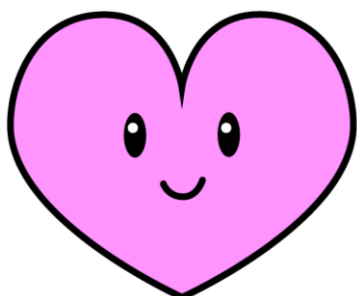
