We are finding a lot of children cannot read the time. Please spend time this summer practicing to read the time both digitally and analogue. Being able to read the time using an analogue clock or digital clock is so important and they are life skills.

Here are the expectations broken down into year groups:

## Year 1

- Before and after
- Days of the week
- Months of the year
- Hours , minutes and seconds
- Tell the time to the hour
- Tell the time to the half hour

## Year 2

- O'clock and half past
- Quarter past and quarter to
- Tell the time past the hour
- Tell the time to the hour
- Tell the time to 5 minutes
- Minutes in an hour
- Hours in a day

## Year 3

- Roman numerals to 12
- Tell the time to 5 minutes
- Tell the time to the minute
- Read time on a digital clock
- Use am and pm
- Years, months and days
- Days and hours
- Hours and minutes - use start and end times
- Hours and minutes - use durations
- Minutes and seconds
- Units of time

## Year 4

- Years, months, weeks and days
- Hours, minutes and seconds
- Convert between analogue and digital times
- Convert to the 24 hour clock
- Convert from the 24 hour clock

## Year 5

- Read and interpret timetables
- Convert units of time
- Calculate with timetables
